Forklift Seat - A sturdy surface to sit down is called a seat. These Seats are typically raised above floor level and the majority of seats utilize four legs and can carry one individual. A stool is a seat which does not have any arm rests or a back rest. A seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, whereas a seat with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has connected wheels, it could be referred to as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is a swing. A permanently attached seat in a train or a theatre is called a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the kind found in vehicles and an infant car seat will be a seat particularly designed for young children.

The design of the seat could vary somewhat significantly so as to accommodate many requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an instance, designs could be decorated with drilled openings, can consist of low backs or gaps for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back can be designed as an included headrest by extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats could be constructed together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is designed to be utilized as a movable footrest. At times the ottoman could be mounted to a glider chair with swing arms, enabling the ottoman to rock back and forth with the glider similar to a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary cloth covers for a seat that can offer protection against wear and add beauty. A large array of seat covers from neoprene to leather are currently offered. More formal materials can be rented for events such as weddings so as to improve the decor. Some seat covers have decorative seat ties or bows connected to be tied behind the seat in a decorative know or ribbon.
